

Yarwood Notes

May 1974

First. you'll note the new heading. I've been trying to think of a satisfactory heading for these memos, and have about decided on "YARWOOD NOTES". If anyone can suggest a better one, I'm open to suggestions.

Second - I had hoped to put this out in April, at least by the end of the month, but didn't get it done. Sorry.

Third - another new aspect. I have two pages of pictures. Some snapshots received from two of my father's cousins. They have been "Veloxed" (sp-?) after being copied and enlarged. Naturally, some detail has been lost. I don't know if I would be able to do this any more.

Fourth - a new section headed "YEARWOOD". Mrs. Wallace H. Smith had heard that I was looking for information on YARWOOD, and wondered if I had run across anything on YEAPWOOD. She sent some information about her family, and that is in this separate section.

By far the largest portion of this "issue" has to do with my own branch, the descendants of George W. YARWOOD & Maria Elizabeth LEE. That portion will be at the end, however it was the first to go to the printers. Except for the pictures. I have them waiting for their proper place in the issue.

Mrs. John M. IRVIN saw one of my "Queries", and sent me quite a few notes she had made for me (she must have put in a fair amount of time, and has no relationship to Yarwood's). I am very grateful to her.

The notes came from Wisconsin census records, probate records, marriage records, tombstones and death records. I have combined her information with some other information about one of the Wisconsin branches - previously reported - and have a "tree". There are probably some errors, as my assumptions may not all be correct. In addition, there are some notes about other YARWOOD's that have no apparent connection to the main tree.

Moses BRIGGS (28 Feb 1814 - 19 May 1876) and wife Alice (29 Aug 1821 - 9 May 1876) probably parents of Ann. Moses & Alice are buried near John YARWOOD & Ann Y. Joseph & John may be related.

"Homer Sholts, son of Martin V. SHOLTS & Almeda Jane BELL, born town of Oregon in Dane County married 28 Jan 1901 in Evansville, Rock County, Wisconsin to Roxie YARWOOD, dau of John B. GREATSINGER & Lydia Alvera GATES (b. Leroy, Illinois."

Vance YARWOOD, son of John YARWOOD, m. Dorothy Keith, lives at Gillett, Oconto Co. Wis. (Probably son of Alfred Y., mentioned in Oct. 1973 letter.)

1723 Feb. 26th *A true list of the Prisoners taken from Newgate, and shipp'd on board the Anne, Capt: Thos Wrangham, Commander, bound for Carolina or Virginia, which were delivered this 21st day of Feby. 1723-4 by Jonathan Howard of London, Merchant--vizt:

23. John YARWOOD.

"* The observant reader will discover, upon scrutinizing this list, that comparatively few of the names here recorded are now known in Virginia. Those recognized are such as are common, wherever natives of Great Britain are to be found. This document was found in Philadelphia; and there is no evidence that those prisoners were ever landed in Virginia; whatever may have been the design of the Home Government. This paper is to be found among the files of the State Library purchases."

1814. March 11 (a letter from Thos. R. Yeatman to Major C. Tompkins, about a trip to Commodore Barrie's ship mentions: "Yarwood, the purser-----"

WILLIAM YARWOOD FAMILY

William YARWOOD, b. England, moved to Smith's Falls, Ontario, Canada about 1906.

William had a brother, John YARWOOD, in the stone & quarry business in Ontario for many years. John's daughter, Lily (YARWOOD) KAMACK was living in Ontario until her death in 1972.

Graduated from National College of Chiropractic in 1931 & commenced practice in Syracuse, N.Y. Moved to Royal Oak, Michigan, 1941, & shortly later was called by the government to head an engineering group of 60 men during the war. Moved to San Diego in 1946 & Costa Mesa, Calif. in 1947 and practiced Chiropractic for many years. He had a stroke in 1968 and is partially paralyzed. He also has diabetes.

Lance m. ca 1931, Dr. Phyllis SCAMACCA, D.C., of Pittston, Pa. who is also a graduate of the National College of Chiropractic.

School of Medicine. Attended Baylor University then Chiropractic college, graduating 1961. Has a chiropractic clinic in Costa Mesa, California.



Mrs. Smith had also received a little information (not much) about early YEARWOODS - A Revolutionary War Pension application of John YEARWOOD, North Carolina was refused.

Some information about Richard YEARWOOD - stepfather of John HARVARD, including his marriage to Katherine ELLETSON 28 May 1627.

There was some connection between Richard YERWOOD (same as above) and Sir George YARDLEY, governor of Virginia.

In Richard YEARWOOD's will, he mentions his daughter Hannah (YEARWOOD) PAYNE.

Ellen YERWOOD was the daughter of Ann PALMER of London and was mentioned in her will.

The Richard YEARWOOD (YERWOOD) above had a son Richard, but Mrs. Smith's source indicated that there was probably no further issue in that line.

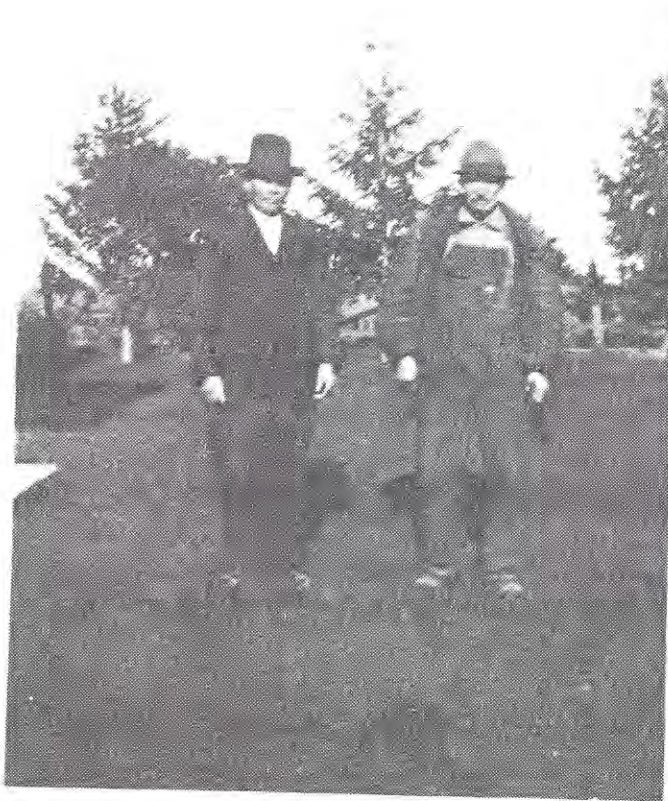
