Yarwood Notes

Dear Folks:

Here is another issue of Notes - not starting a regular series, but perhaps I'll be able to get one out about this time each year(I hope)

When I last wrote - last November - things were really up in the air. No-one knew anything about what to expect. Well, five men from our lab were laid off. Luckily, they all found other jobs, with the one out the longest having to look for a month.
